

## 2011 NEC Changes Part 1 (Online)

<b>Credit Hours</b>	8 hours
<b>Course Timetable</b>	Attached
<b>Course Description</b>	This course will review the first half of the most important National Electrical Code changes from the 2011 NEC. Changes in Articles 90 – 406.12 will be covered.
<b>Course Objectives</b>	After completing this course the licensee will be able to apply changes to the 2011 NEC from Article 90 through Article 406.12 in common wiring practice.
<b>Method of Presentation</b>	The online course requires the participant to answer multiple choice questions after reviewing the content. After all the questions have been answered, the user must affirm they are the one who completed the course and verify that their registration information is correct.
<b>Method of Evaluation</b>	The licensee must complete all 125 multiple choice questions with a score of at least 75% in order to get credit for the course. Credit will not be awarded unless the licensee has completely answered all questions and the passing grade has been met.
