

# Installing Services According to the 2011 NEC

<b>Credit Hours</b>	4 Hours Online
<b>Course Timetable</b>	Attached
<b>Course Description</b>	This course will focus on the 2011 NEC requirements for installing electrical services. Definitions of Service Conductors and Service Equipment will be discussed. The requirements for the most common types of electrical service installations in Article 230 will be covered in detail. Installing services to a sample Strip Shopping Center will be used as a course exercise.
<b>Course Objectives</b>	After completing this course the participant will be able to apply the basic National Electrical Code rules for installing conductors and equipment for electrical services.
<b>Method of Presentation</b>	This course requires the participant to answer multiple choice questions after reviewing the content. After all the questions have been answered, the user must affirm they are the one who completed the course and verify that their registration information is correct. A user will not be able to complete the course until the test questions have been passed. The course will also be timed, and users will not be given credit until they have spent at least 200 minutes in the course.
<b>Method of Evaluation</b>	The licensee must complete all 50 multiple choice questions with a score of at least 70% in order to get credit for the course. Credit will not be awarded unless the licensee has completely answered all 50 questions and the passing grade has been met.
