

# House Wiring

<b>Credit Hours</b>	4
<b>Course Timetable</b>	Attached
<b>Course Description</b>	This course covers sections of the 2008 NEC based on residential wiring. The subsections include: services and subpanels, kitchen pantry and dining rooms, bathrooms and laundry, living areas (and bedrooms), stairways and hallways, luminaires, fans and switches, outdoors, garages, basements and crawl spaces, heating and cooling, swimming pools and spas, generators, limited energy, installation and wiring methods, and practical exercises.
<b>Course Objectives</b>	After completing this course, each participant will be able to recognize and apply the 2008 National Electrical Code to wiring installations in residential dwelling units.
<b>Method of Presentation</b>	The course will feature randomization, personal ID questions, a timer, and loopback. For the online version, the randomization means that each subsection will have the sections appear in a randomized order for each user. The answer choices will also appear in a randomized order. For the homestudy version, there will be two different versions. The personal ID questions consist of 5 personal questions which the user must answer before beginning the online course. Then, the user will be asked the questions throughout the course. An incorrect answer will force the user to be logged out. The timer requires that a user spend at least 3 hours and 20 minutes in the course before they can be given credit for course completion.
<b>Method of Evaluation</b>	The licensee must answer all multiple choice questions; A passing score of 75% is required for course completion.
