ITS Wireless Services



Wireless Services

The ITS Wireless Services team provides essential wireless communication equipment services for state, federal and local government agencies. "If it can talk without wires they can install, repair and maintain it." The Wireless Services team is comprised of three functional sections:

- Microwave
- Two-Way Radio
- Vehicle Equipment

Microwave Service

ITS Microwave Technicians install, maintain and optimize microwave equipment at over twenty-eight mountaintop communication sites. The microwave at these locations provides urban and rural cities and towns throughout the state with digital voice and data services.

The Microwave team maintains physical plants at communication sites and coordinates communication site construction—critical to key State infrastructure.

The State owns, manages and leases space at more than fifty communication sites, most in very remote locations.

Two-Way Radio Service



The Two-Way Radio team is geographically dispersed. With shops in Salt Lake, Ogden, Cedar City, Price and Richfield, ITS Radio Technicians install and support wireless two-way radio technologies for customer organizations throughout the state.

The two primary two-way radio systems are the Law Enforcement System (LES) and the State Repeater System (SRS). Federal, state and local government agencies rely on these systems for their daily mission-critical communication needs. Both systems are linked to Consolidated 911 Dispatch Centers statewide.

The team also maintains Dispatch Console equipment in use at Emergency Services Dispatch Centers.

Vehicle Equipment Service



The Vehicle Installation team has witnessed exponential growth in meeting the needs for quality equipment installation in field vehicles. Gone are the days when Highway Patrol cars contained a simple suite of radio, light bar and siren equipment.

Now ITS Vehicle Installers routinely install and repair video cameras, push bumpers, dog cages, shotgun racks, radar guns, an extensive array of lighting and messaging electronics and the mobile units used for the Mobile Data Network.



Each member of the installation team is a Mobile Electronics Certified Professional (MECP). This certification is nationally recognized as the highest standard in the profession.
