## Wasatch Front Consortium APPEL Program Corrective Action Progress (CAP) Update 11/17/2023

The Wasatch Front Consortium (WFC) Alternate Pathway to Professional Educator License (APPEL) received a Corrective Action Plan (CAP) dated November 10, 2022 and entered probationary status. Below is an update of all conditions in the CAP as of November 17, 2023.
