Audit Filter 1 (no longer monitored due to data availability)

Trauma patients with more than one (in-state) inter-hospital transfer prior to definitive care.

Audit Filter 2

Trauma patients with 1) an ISS greater than 15 or 2) penetrating trauma with EMS scene times greater than 10 minutes.

Audit Filter 3

Transferred (out) trauma patients with an ISS greater than 15 and ED time greater than 90 minutes.

Audit Filter 4

- a) Trauma patients who die with a probability of survival (TRISS) >=75%
- b) Trauma patients who live with a probability of survival (TRISS) <=25% (TRISS score for trauma patients using physiologic measures collected at the presenting hospital)

Audit Filter 5

Trauma patients with an ISS greater than 15 who are discharged from non-designated trauma centers.

Audit Filter 6

Trauma patients <15 years old who either had 1) an ED GCS <=13, 2) were intubated, or 3) ISS > 15 and were not transferred to a regional pediatric trauma center

Audit Filter 7 (No longer monitored due to data availability)

Trauma patients who meet the criteria of Steps 1 and 2 of the CDC Trauma Field Triage Guidelines and are not transported to the highest level trauma center within (or nearby) the (Trauma) region. (NEMSIS v3.4 data element elnjury.03 seldom filled in)

Audit Filter 8

Trauma patients who die greater than one hour after ED arrival (Calculated as the time from ED arrival to ED-discharge (include patients transferred from different facilities)
