ITEM 1 Josh Arrington requests Design Review approval for a new 75,000 square foot office building on a three-acre campus in the R&BP (Research and Business Park) Zone, located at 388 W River Bend Lane.

The following action was taken on the above described item by the Design Review Committee at its regular meeting on December 14, 2023:

Condition: 1. That the applicant demonstrates the use of the high-quality materials expressed in the hearing.

James Hall was present as chair.

The following is a brief summary of the above decision, including conditions of approval:

- Josh Arrington displayed new colored renderings of the proposed project and described the elements and features of the design.
- When asked about the materials, Mr. Arrington described using glass, formed concrete, ACM metal panels, and either bronze toned wood product or a high-quality wood veneer.
- The Committee described a diversity of styles in the Riverwoods Business Park, staff and the applicant stated that there was no consistent surrounding theme or design to attempt to match to meet Section 14.34.280.
- Members of the Committee asked about protection for the wood and the applicant explained that the wood will just be a fascia and soffit detail, which are typically protected better from the weather, but will have a protectant included.
- Overall, the Committee liked the design, the diversity it brings to the area, and the heavy landscaping for a connection to nature. The only concern was not being able to confirm whether the materials will be of high-quality at the hearing without a materials board.
- Motion was made to approve the design with a note that the use of high-quality materials described by Mr. Arrington would be required on the final product.
