

## Utility Rate Trends

#### Sewer

Current Rate \$49.50

- Debt Coverage requirement 125%
- Current Outlook 130%
- Last Increase August 2020
- Recommend auto increase of 3%
- Recommended Inc = \$1.49

#### Water

Current Rate \$20.69

- Built In Automatic 3% Increase set by Ordinance
- Next increase = \$0.62
- New Rate = \$21.31
- Recommended Increase \$4.00

#### Garbage

1<sup>st</sup> \$15.30, 2nd \$11.20, Recycle \$11.20

- Contract Increase = 5%
- Garbage Equipment Trend = \$31,000 or 0.05%
- Recommended increase = 1st can = \$0.77
  2nd/Recycle = \$0.57

#### Storm Drain

Current Rate \$6.00

- Last Increase June 2022
- automatic increase of 3% = \$0.18
- Recommended increase of \$0.34
