NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the following public hearing has been scheduled to be heard by the Clearfield Planning Commission at 6:30 p.m. on Wednesday, March 6, 2024, and the Clearfield City Council at 7:00 pm on Tuesday, April 9, 2024. The meetings will be held in the Council Chambers on the 3rd Floor of the City Municipal Center located at 55 South State Street, Clearfield, Utah 84015.

Public Hearing, Discussion and Possible Action on **ZTA 2024-0205**, a zoning text amendment request by Clearfield City to amend the transition setback in the Downtown Form Based Code. (**Legislative Action**).

The proposed changes remove the language referencing existing single-family homes and keeps the language referencing single-family residentially zoned properties adjacent to new development in the form-based code area.

All interested persons present will be given an opportunity to be heard. Written comments may also be submitted, by mail to Clearfield City, Community Development, 55 South State Street, Clearfield, UT 84015. Written comments not received prior to the date of the meeting may not be able to be considered.
