- **Section 400.** Ball and Chain are attached to prisoners in public.



Spanish Flu left a lasting impression.

- Full chapter and multiple sections related to quarantine protocols. CHAPTER XXIV is dedicated to that purpose



- Section 545: Roller Skating. Unlawful to roller skate on public streets except at crossings.
- Section 636: Improper dancing prohibited
- Section 52: Children under 12 couldn't play on the railroad tracks
- Section 63: One of the duties of the cemetery sexton is to keep cattle out of the cemetery.



- Section 91: The owner is required to kill a dog if they don't intend to pay the \$1.50 annual dog tax
- Section 504: "No dazzling lights" lights over four lumens on a vehicle prohibited (headlights now max out at 1100 lumens)
- Section 166: requires a permit approved by the council to sell ice
- Section 117: Selling "Hercules" powder, nitroglycerine, and dynamite must be sanctioned by the city council.
- Section 227: Unlawful to indecently exhibit a horse or bull...
- Section 155: Unlawful to kill an animal under four weeks old for food



- Section 241: Unlawful to keep a disorderly house
- Section 262: Horses must be hitched
- Section 289: sabbath breaking prohibited
- Section 422C: unlawful to ride on the bumper of a car unless in danger
- Section 510: When parking at a curb, you have to park at a 45-degree angle.



- Section 220 Unlawful to help a prisoner escape But more pointedly, “using liquor to help prisoners escape is [really] unlawful.” Probably a good story here.

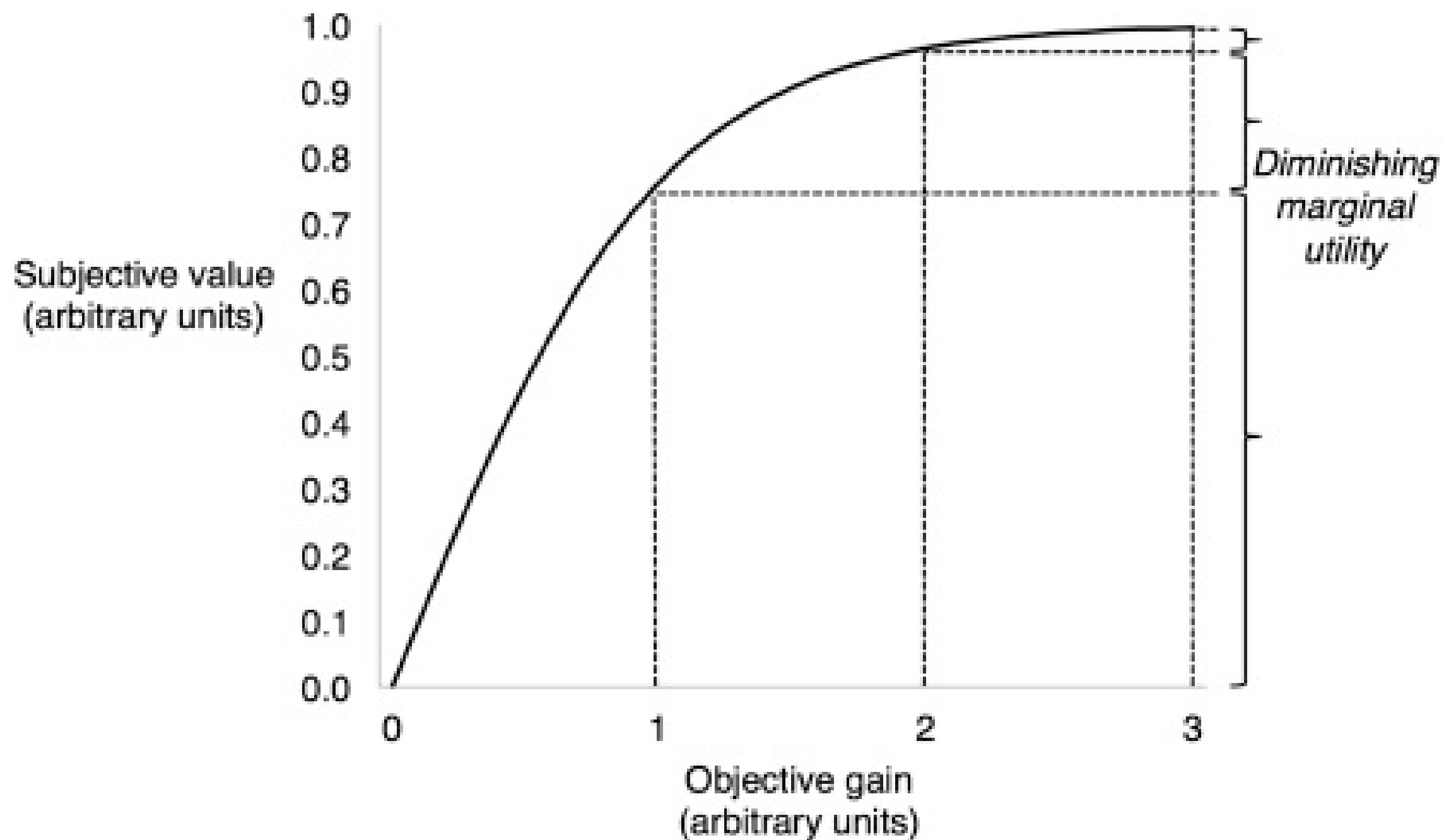




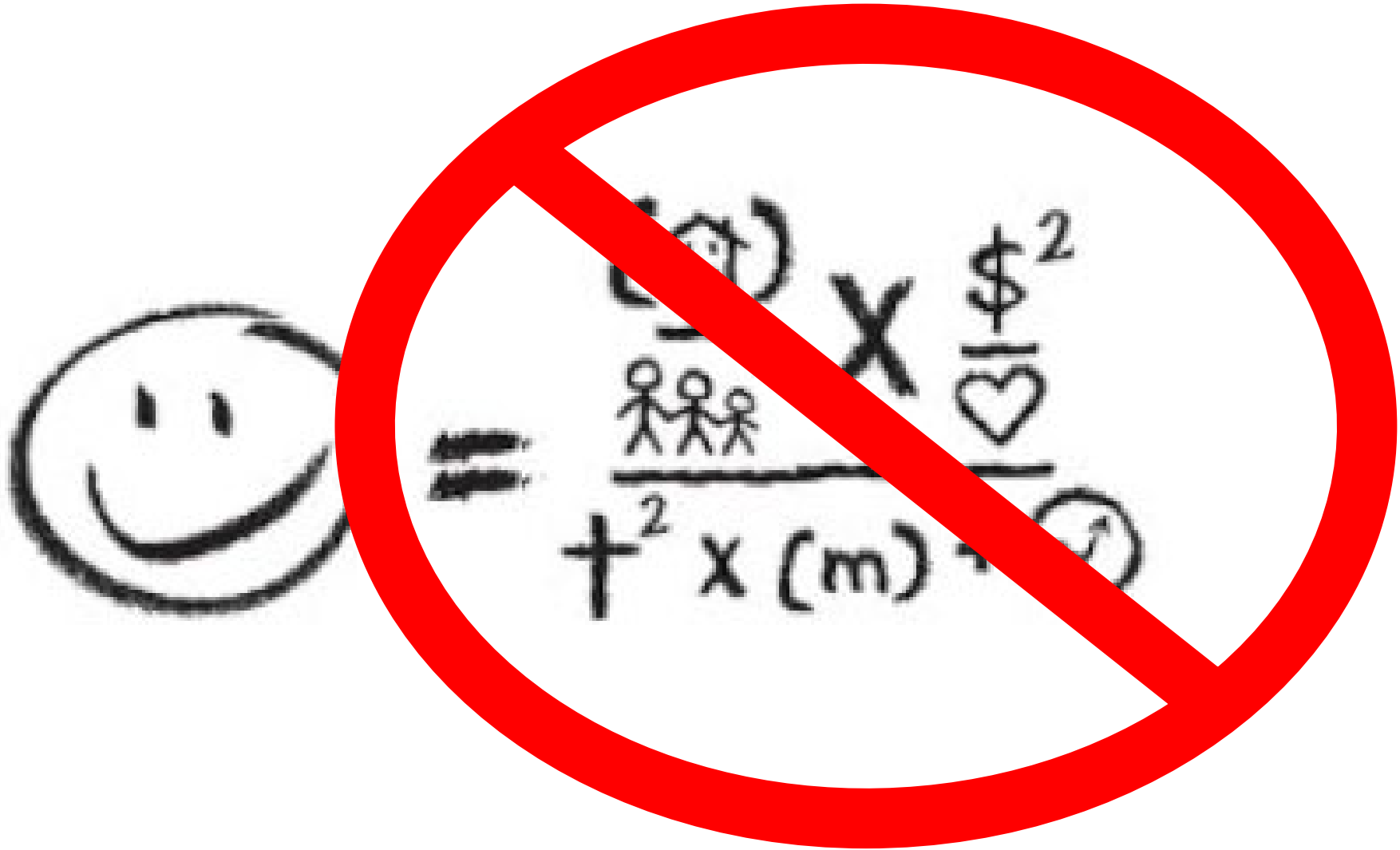
Life only pleasure = Suffering
