






QUIT RATES BY SECTOR AND INDUSTRY IN 2021*








GENERAL PROVISIONS

- Purchasing Agent Designated. The City Manager or appointed designee
 is hereby appointed and designated as the Farmington City purchasing agent. The
 Purchasing Agent may from time to time appoint another person to undertake all
 or some of the duties of the Purchasing Agent set forth herein or appointed to
 them.
- 2. Authority to Enter into and Execute Contracts. All contracts are to follow the approval thresholds as outlined in "Authorization Requirements for Purchases" in this policy. All contracts must be reviewed by the City Attorney prior to execution and approved 'as to form'. All contracts in violation of this provision are considered void and may result in the personal obligation and liability of persons at fault for such violations.
- Competitive Procurement. Unless exempted by this policy, all purchases and contracts shall be awarded on a competitive basis, as required by this


