Free Standing ED Field Triage/Audit Filters Dr. Katie Russell,MD/Dr. Peter Taillac, MD	<ul> <li>The general idea is to prevent EMS from bringing trauma patients that are likely to need a second transfer to freestanding EDs to avoid delay in care as there may not be a surgeon at that facility.</li> <li>Dr. Taillac reviewed the state's Guidelines for Transport of Trauma Patients to Freestanding Emergency Departments.</li> <li>This discussion will continue in the next meeting.</li> </ul>

UPTN Matt Eyre, RN/Dr, Swindiman, MD  ● UPTN Updates	<ul> <li>Matt reminded everyone that the Utah Pediatric Trauma Network's purpose is to establish a network that includes all five of the trauma regions and every hospital in the state. Together they collectively implement injury prevention initiatives, evidence based practice in transfer guidelines with the goal of improving outcomes.
