

DRAFT Utah Teaching Competency Evaluation Criteria for Approval

All teacher competency evaluations shall meet the following criteria:

- 1. The teaching competency evaluation is aligned with the <u>Utah Effective Teaching</u> <u>Standards</u> (R277-330-6), as approved by the Board.
- 2. The teaching competency evaluation is aligned with the <u>General Teacher</u> <u>Preparation Competencies</u> (R277-304-4), as approved by the Board.
- 3. The teaching competency evaluation measures the following <u>General Teacher</u> <u>Preparation Competencies</u>, as approved by the Board:
 - a. **Learners & Learning LL2:** Design learning that builds on the learner's background knowledge and supports students' needs.
 - b. **Instructional Clarity IC2:** Create learning intentions and success criteria that are aligned to Utah Core Standards.
 - c. **Instructional Clarity IC4:** Plan learning progressions that build upon students' previous learning and support current learning intentions.
 - d. **Instructional Clarity IC6:** Allow students multiple opportunities and means for demonstration of competency.
 - e. **Instructional Clarity IC7:** Design a variety of instructional strategies to engage students and promote active learning.
 - f. **Instructional Practice IP3:** Analyze student assessment data, including both formative and summative assessments, to inform and adjust instruction.
 - g. **Instructional Practice IP4:** Employ a variety of assessments that allow all students to demonstrate learning.
 - h. **Instructional Practice IP5:** Provide feedback to students and families that supports learning and growth.
 - i. **Instructional Practice IP6:** Provide relevant learning opportunities that are grounded in student interests, needs, and backgrounds.
- 4. The teaching competency evaluation requires the candidate to document his/her own instruction throughout the teaching cycle including his/her design and preparation of lessons, execution of the instruction, and reflective analysis and assessment of the instruction leading to further design and implementation.
- 5. The teaching competency evaluation uses a valid and reliable tool.
- The teaching competency evaluation will protect the privacy of the candidate and the students in the classroom as dictated by federal and state law as well as LEA policies.
