# Noelle Pikus Pace


Keynote Speaker



In 2014, Noelle was awarded the US Olympic's iconic "Moment of the Games" when she jumped into the stands to embrace her family after winning the Olympic Silver Medal in the sport of skeleton. Her journey to the Olympics was not a clear and simple path. From the onset, she found herself facing countless trials and obstacles along the way. As the world's #1 skeleton racer in 2005, she was hit by a bobsled in a tragic accident that cost her the Olympic spot in the 2006 Torino games. Through hard work, hope and determination, Noelle made a comeback the following year to become the 1st American woman to win World Championships, and she did it by the largest margin in the history of the sport. Through triumph and heartache over the next 4 years, her dream to make it to the Olympics came to fruition in 2010, when she competed at the Vancouver Winter Games, just falling short of the podium. With an eager determination to reach that Olympic podium, she returned to win the silver medal in the 2014 Sochi Winter Olympics. Noelle is a 26x world cup medalist, 2x world champion, MBA, author of "Focused" and mom of 4 kids.
