1. PLEDGE OF ALLEGIANCE

Mayor Kourianos called the regular meeting to order at 5:32 p.m. Eric Nelson, Trinity Christian Center offered a word. Mayor Kourianos led the Pledge of Allegiance.

2. ROLL CALL

Roll was called with the above Councilmembers and staff in attendance.

3. SAFETY SECONDS

Councilmember Knott-Jespersen reminded everyone to pay attention when driving, watch speed limit signs, do not drive drowsy or distracted.

4. PUBLIC COMMENT

Councilmember Miller stepped away from the dais to the podium and read aloud an email from Amanda McIntosh, SEUHD Suicide Prevention Specialist because she was unable to attend the meeting in person. The email sent by Amanda states that she is supporting K-9 training for PeeDee, Price City Police K-9, which is an agenda item on consent agenda. Councilmember Miller read the following:

Dear Mayor Kourianos and Price City Council Members,

My name is Amanda McIntosh, and I am a Price City resident. Thank you for the opportunity to make a public comment tonight while being absent. I would like to express my support on agenda item 6b: K-9 TRAINING. Consideration and possible approval for facility psychiatric service dog training package for PeeDee, Price City Police K-9, with Dog Training Elite Utah County.

Although I am not an expert on Emotional Support Animals, through my work in mental health and suicide prevention with the health department and the HOPE Squad of Carbon, Emery and Grand Counties, as well as my position with the American Foundation for Suicide Prevention, I have personally seen the positive impacts emotional support animals have on mental health conditions and more specifically PTSD and trauma. When we talk about protective factors for positive mental health and

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building support systems for people with depressive symptoms, their animals are often a part of their healing journey. I suspect it would be nothing less for our law enforcement officers. Price City Police Department and I have worked very hard together to bring funding to the Peer Support Fund through the "Peer Support Fundraisers" for our officers. Training PeeDee would only amplify those self-help-seeking measures.

I would like to encourage the council to approve PeeDee's training through Dog Training Elite. I have talked with Chief Sicilia and believe he is committed and passionate about taking on this endeavor to improve the department and our city. We have already seen the love and support that PeeDee has received in the community; he is beloved and is Price City's protective factor. I support Chief Sicilia and PeeDee in receiving this training and know it will only strengthen our officers' mental well-being and continued service to Price City and beyond.

Admittedly, there are not a lot of evidence-based studies that look into the benefits of an emotional support animal and police officers however, I found a few published papers that echo my beliefs. The first one published by the International Association of Chiefs of Police entitled "The Impact of Dogs on Resilience: Facility and Therapy Dog Programs to Enhance Officer Wellness" (linked in this email) says:

"Interactions with dogs have been shown to lower an individual's heart rate and blood pressure levels. Studies also show that interactions between humans and dogs help alleviate Post Traumatic Stress Disorder (PTSD) symptoms. By serving as a distraction or relief from symptoms, dogs can help individuals cope with depression and other mental health conditions. When recovering from trauma, regular, structured interactions with dogs have been found to reduce participants' self-reported fear, anxiety, depression, and sleep disturbance. In other words, dogs help reduce anxiety by providing immediate calm and offering support without judgment."

Another paper entitled "Animal Assisted Therapy on Law Enforcement Mental Health: A Therapy Dog Implementation Guide" states:

"Mental health and mental illness are struggles experienced by many people in our society, but a population that is affected even more than average by it is that of law enforcement. Compared to the general population, law enforcement officials report much higher rates of depression, PTSD, burnout, and other anxiety-related mental health conditions (NAMI, 2020)." "Some of the most common mental health issues seen within the law enforcement field are that of anxiety, depression, PTSD, and suicidal ideation or behavior. Within the United States, it is estimated that there are likely at least one-quarter million first responders suffering from full- or partial-PTSD (Haugen et al., 2012) and in 2019 alone at least 228 police officers died of suicide alone (Barr, 2020; Shannon, 2020). This number is higher than the number of police officers killed in the line of duty last year and is evidence of the state of mental health in our law enforcement officials, making the provision of effective interventions for this population both necessary and justified."

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It shall not be modified or amended except in writing signed by the parties hereto and specifically referring to this Agreement. This Agreement shall take precedence over any other documents that may be in conflict therewith.

18. RELATIONSHIP OF THE PARTIES.

The parties to this Agreement are independent contractors and this Agreement will not establish any relationship of partnership, joint venture, employment, franchise, or agency between the parties. Neither party will have the power to bind the other party or incur obligations on the other party's behalf without the other party's prior written consent.

19. DEVELOPER ACCOUNTS

When the Licensee's name in the app stores, the procedures to procure a developer account in the name of the Licensee is required.

To be able to submit the Developed App on behalf of the Licensee, the Licensor must be granted Admin access to the organizational developer account on both Apple's Developer Portal and the Google Play Admin Console. Apple requires all developer accounts be secured in the name of the business or organization that owns or represents the content (the Licensee) used in the app. Thus, the Licensee will be required to secure a developer account on both Apple and Google Play for the purposes of submitting the Developed App.

The Licensor must be added as an administrator to all developer accounts to manage the submission process of the Developed App and to maintain the ongoing viability of the Developed App to meet the standards set by Apple and Google Play regarding technical requirements. Once the Licensor is added as a user with Admin privileges on the developer account, they will manage the submission process and ensure the Developed App is maintained at a quality level agreeable to Apple & Google Play's standards.

If the Licensee does not acquire a developer account successfully in an acceptable amount of time to submit the Developed App for approval, the Licensor is not responsible. In such case, the Licensee will remain responsible for full payment of the licensing fee previously agreed upon in this Agreement.

If the Licensee's Developer Name does not match the App Name in a way that satisfies Apple and Google Play to accept the Developed App, resulting in Licensor being unable to submit the Developed App, the Licensor is not responsible, and the Licensee remains responsible for full payment of the license fee.

If the App Name matches the Developer Name, and the Developer account is secured in a fair amount of time to allow approval of the Developed App prior to the event (at least 10 days prior to the event start date), and the Developed App is not approved due to issues with the submission, the Licensee shall receive a full refund of all fees paid by Licensee under this Agreement. The foregoing does not limit in any way the rights and remedies of Licensee hereunder.

The Licensee will follow the procedures to secure an organizational developer account on both Apple & Google Play for the purposes of submitting an App for use.

All informational content within the Developed App will be the responsibility of the Licensee and its agents to manage after initial design & setup, with the assistance of the Licensor as needed.

11. CONFIDENTIALITY

Neither party will use the other party's Confidential Information (as defined below) for reasons other than as and to the extent necessary for the performance of this Agreement and neither party will disclose such Confidential Information to any third party except to those of its employees and subcontractors that need to know such Confidential Information for the purpose of performing its obligations under this Agreement, provided that each such employee and subcontractor is subject to a written agreement that includes binding use and disclosure restrictions that are at least as protective as those set forth herein. Each party will use all reasonable efforts to maintain the confidentiality of the other party's Confidential Information, but in no event less than the efforts that such party ordinarily uses with respect to its own Confidential Information of similar importance. The foregoing obligations will not restrict either party from disclosing Confidential Information of the other party pursuant to the order or requirement of a court, administrative agency, or other governmental body, provided that the party required to make such a disclosure gives reasonable notice to the other party to enable it to contest the order or requirement. "Confidential Information" means: (a) the Developed App and the Specifications; (b) the Licensor Technology; (c) any business or technical information of either party including, without limitation, any information relating to a party's designs, finances, marketing plans, business opportunities, personnel, or development that is designated in writing by the disclosing party as "confidential" or "proprietary" at the time of disclosure or that, due to its nature or the circumstances of its disclosure, should reasonably be considered confidential; and (d) the specific terms and conditions of this Agreement.

12. JURISDICTION AND DISPUTES

In the event the app is NOT launched within 6 months of signing the Agreement due solely to the Licensee not providing content or other delays caused by Licensee's fault, Licensee is subject to an additional \$500 fee to carry the contract over to a subsequent cycle. This is done to defray accounting costs, additional server costs, and the cost of higher-priced staffing since the project started.

It will be Licensor's obligation to pay all taxes due on the compensation received under this Agreement, and Licensor will indemnify Licensee and hold Licensee harmless from any obligation to pay any type of taxes (excluding only sales taxes), or other obligation imposed in connection with any payments made to Licensor by Licensee pursuant to this Agreement.

7. WARRANTIES

- a. Licensor represents and warrants that the App Platform and Licensee's use thereof in accordance with this Agreement do not and will not infringe, misappropriate, or violate any rights of any third party including, without limitation, any intellectual property and privacy rights of any third party.
- b. Licensor represents and warrants that the Developed App and web-based administrative tools necessary for Licensee and its users' proper use of the Developed App will perform in accordance with the Specifications and highest industry standards. Licensor will promptly, at its expense, correct any errors or issues with the performance of the Developed App or web-based administrative tools reported by Licensee to Licensor.
- c. In no event shall either party be liable for any incidental, consequential, or punitive damages as a result of its performance or breach of this Agreement. Notwithstanding anything herein to the contrary, the limitations on types and amounts of damages set forth above, will not apply to claims, losses or damages arising in connection with a Licensor's indemnification obligations, gross negligence, willful misconduct, breach of confidentiality obligations or non-compliance with law.
- d. Licensor represents and warrants that: (a) Licensor is financially solvent and has the ability to perform its obligations hereunder; (b) the person signing below is a duly authorized officer or representative of Licensor with the authority to enter into and bind Licensor to the terms and conditions in this Agreement.
- e. Licensor represents and warrants that: (a) all Services will be performed in a competent manner by qualified personnel and all Products and Services will be provided on a timely basis; (b) any Products/Services provided are of good quality, material and workmanship, new, merchantable, fit for its intended purpose and free from any and all defects; (c) any Products/Services provided, and the Deliverables do not infringe the intellectual property rights or any other rights of any third parties; (d) all Products are sold free and clear of all liens and encumbrances; (e) Licensor owns, licenses and/or has the right to grant and extend any licenses provided to Licensee hereunder; (f) the Services will be provided by Licensor's personnel having the appropriate level of skills and training and each of Licensor's employees and subcontractors who has been or will be involved in the development of the Developed App, or who will have access to any Confidential Information (as defined below) of Licensee, will have signed, prior to beginning such involvement, an agreement with Licensor that effects an assignment of all intellectual property rights in the Developed App to Licensor and that ensures Licensor's compliance with its obligations regarding Licensee's Confidential Information, as set forth in Section 11; (g) the Deliverables do not contain any virus, spyware, malware or disabling code designed to or that (i) may be used to access, alter, delete, damage, disable, cause disruption of or otherwise interfere with Licensee's use of the Developed App, or any software, hardware, computer system, network, data or information used by Licensee in connection with the Developed App; or (ii) would permit Licensor to access the Developed App or the environment or systems of Licensee or any customer of Licensee using the Developed App; and (j) Licensor has not entered into and will not enter into any other agreement that conflicts with this Agreement or limits Licensor's ability to perform the Services hereunder.
- f. Licensor will correct any warranty failure within ten (10) days of Licensee reporting the failure to Licensor. If Licensor is unable to provide a mutually agreeable solution to the failure after notice from Licensee, at Licensee's option, Licensor will refund to Licensee all amounts paid by Licensee for the failed Services or defective Product.

The following termination rights are in addition to the termination rights that may be provided elsewhere in the Agreement

2. LICENSE

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ADDENDUM TO ADVERTISING BASE AGREEMENT BETWEEN PRICE CITY AND CASTLE COUNTRY RADIO FOR THE MUTUALLY AGREED UPON EXTENSION OF ADVERTISING CONTRACT TERMS

The purpose of this Addendum (hereinafter referred to as the "Addendum") is to memorialize and detail the terms and conditions under which Castle Country Radio (hereinafter referred to as "CCR".), having an address of P.O.Box 875 Price, UT 84501 and Price Municipal Corporation (hereinafter referred to as "City"), having an address of 185 Main Street / PO Box 893, Price, UT 84501, shall agree to extend the contact terms and conditions of a prior advertising agreement between CCR and City creating the Addendum to the prior advertising agreement executed between CCR and City (hereinafter referred to as the "Base Agreement") Collectively CCR and City shall be referred to as the "Parties" to this Addendum.

RECITALS

WHEREAS, City has a need to procure and utilize local radio advertising; and,

WHEREAS, CCR owns and operates radio stations in the local area; and,

WHEREAS, CCR did not submit a proposal for new and updated local radio advertising terms and conditions to City during a recent Request for Proposals and Bidding process; and,

WHEREAS, the Parties have successfully contracted with each other for local radio advertising services in the past thereby lowering the transaction costs associated with regular and ongoing radio advertising needs of City as placed with CCR; and,

WHEREAS, the Parties have mutually negotiated in good faith and agreed that an Addendum to the Base Agreement, extending the Base Agreement terms and conditions is in the best interest of both Parties hereto; and,

WHEREAS, the Parties have mutually agreed to this Addendum to extend the terms and conditions of the Base Agreement, attached herewith in <u>Exhibit 1</u> to this Addendum, and by this reference made a part hereof, for a period of five (5) years, beginning on July 1st, 2024 and ending on June 30th, 2029; and,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT HEREBY AGREED AND UNDERSTOOD BY THE PARTIES HERETO AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. City Obligations.

1. Shall pay CCR on an annual basis pursuant to the payment schedule below within thirty (30) days of receipt of invoice for the annual fiscal year:

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- a. The payment for fiscal year 2024-2025, to be made promptly after July 1st, 2024, will be \$6,600.00.
- b. The payment for fiscal year 2025-2026, to be made promptly after July 1st, 2025, will be \$6,600.00.

- c. The payment for fiscal year 2026-2027, to be made promptly after July 1st, 2026, will be \$6,930.00.
- d. The payment for fiscal year 2027-2028, to be made promptly after July 1st, 2027, will be \$7,276.00.
- e. The payment for fiscal year 2028-2029, to be made promptly after July 1st, 2028, will be \$7,640.00.

Section 2. CCR Obligations.

- 1. Shall provide radio advertising and radio advertising consulting services in the following categories to City each year throughout the term of this Addendum:
 - a. International Days All
 - b. Culture Connection All
 - c. Price City Desert Wave Pool All
 - d. Price City Library All
 - e. Public Notices and Classified Type Advertising All
 - f. Get Local-Buy Local, Halloween Safety, Santa Tracker, Misc and Unexpected.
- 2. Regularly communicate with City regarding advertising needs in all identified subject areas

<u>Section 3. Authority</u>. The Parties hereto, City and CCR, represent that the individual person executing his Addendum on its respective behalf has the authority to do so and the authority to bind the party.

<u>Section 4. Notices</u>. All notices and other communication in regard to this Addendum and the subject matter thereof, shall be in writing and shall be sufficient for all purposes if personal delivered or mailed via U.S. Mail or email.

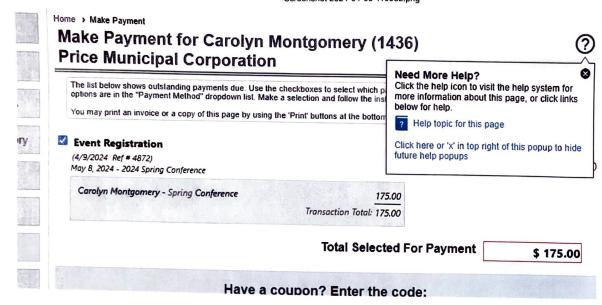

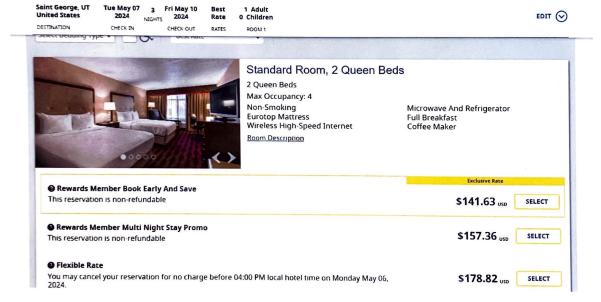

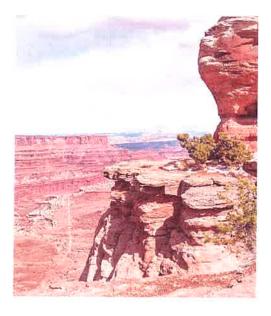
