Background:

Staff recommends amending the rule to update definitions, clarify the timing of license renewals, allow for one extension of an Associate license, update requirements for an Associate and Out of State license, update candidate appeal rights, and make technical changes. Additionally, staff recommends updates to be consistent with 2024 HB 208, which requires alternative pathways for educator licensure, which does not include completion of the PRAXIS exam.

Staff will present R277-301, Draft 3, for consideration and approval.
