22	library materials are housed and administered by professional staff hired to oversee the
23	selection, maintenance, and access to school library materials.

27	(1) On or before September 1, 2022 <u>2024</u> each LEA shall:
28	(a) establish a policy and accompanying procedures for the selection and
29	reconsideration of library materials selected for a school's library that is:

30	(i) consistent with current state and federal law, including 53G-10-103; and

32	(ii) designates two or more LEA employees responsible for making the initial
