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## 18. ADOPT A RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF UTAH COUNTY, UTAH, APPROVING AN INTERLOCAL COOPERATION AGREEMENT BETWEEN UTAH COUNTY AND UTAH TRANSIT AUTHORITY

Commissioner Witney discussed financing with Utah County Clerk/Auditor Bryan E. Thompson. Mr. Thompson asked about county control in the year 2028, and Matt Dugdale of George K. Baum and Company explained how Utah Transit Authority (UTA) and Utah County have negotiated the details. If UTA is unable to bond in 2028 because of the market or other issues, they are still contractually obligated; however, the county can exercise discretion in how payments are made. Commissioner Anderson commented on the relationship between Utah County and UTA being one full of trust.

The commissioners continued to discuss details with Bryan E. Thompson, Utah County Civil Division Chief Deputy Attorney E. Kent Sundberg, and council for Utah Transit Authority. Commissioner Ellertson confirmed funding from the Mountainland Association of Governments (MAG), and Commissioner Anderson spoke about this being a regional project - not just directly impacting Provo/Orem and important for overall economic development. Commissioner Ellertson noted for the record that while this is a UTA project, Utah County support and funds are vital; the two are working hand in hand. The money being put into this will be returned to the county and can be used for future projects.

E. Kent Sundberg commented on the Metropolitan Planning Organization (MPO), and Commissioner Anderson mentioned that it was recommended for approval. Commissioner Witney agreed that while the project is great, he is concerned about funds and timing. Commissioner Ellertson encouraged the Board to look to the future.
