

## 2015 NOTICE OF ELECTION FRUIT HEIGHTS CITY, UTAH

Fruit Heights City will hold its Caucus Meetings for the Pinecone and Sagebrush Parties on Tuesday, August 11, 2015 to seek nominees for three city council openings. Successful nominees will then run in the General Election on Tuesday, November 3, 2015. Fruit Heights City Elections are non-partisan.

Municipal council members serve four-year terms and are elected at-large.

The incumbents are:

Anyone interested in one of these offices must:

- Be a U.S. citizen at time of nomination
- Be a registered voter of Fruit Heights City
- Be at least 18 years old
- Be a resident of Fruit Heights City for at least 365 consecutive days immediately preceding the date of election (November 3, 2015)
- Not be a convicted felon

Each person seeking to become a candidate for a municipal office should attend the Pinecone or Sagebrush Caucus Meetings which will be held on Tuesday, August 11, 2015 at 7:00 pm at the Fruit Heights City Office Building, 910 S. Mountain Road.
