
## Project Overview

The Utah Transit Authority (UTA), in cooperation with the Utah Department of Transportation (UDOT), is preparing an environmental study report for transit improvements through South Davis County to Salt Lake City. The general study area falls between the Wasatch Mountains on the east and the Legacy Parkway and I-215 alignments on the west.

The proposed transit improvements include a rail extension from the central business district of Salt Lake City, Utah to Centerville City in Davis County, Utah through the cities of North Salt Lake, Woods Cross, and Bountiful. Two rail technologies are being considered: light rail and streetcar; see the figures below for more detail. The proposed improvements also include a bus extension from Centerville City to Farmington City, Utah. The proposed project (also known as the locally preferred alternative or LPA) is the result of an alternatives analysis conducted in 2007.
