ESL and Evening Activities

This year we have partnered with the SLCO Refugee Liaison, Active Aging ESL, and Taylorsville City to coordinate an evening time ESL class for refugees from Sudan, Congo, South Sudan, and Chad. The program funding is for 1 year. The class currently serves 10-16 individuals Monday and Wednesday evenings from 5:30 to 7:30.

This program has given Taylorsville Senior Center an amazing opportunity to serve our community. The seniors in the ESL class not only benefit from learning English, but they are able to use the center for fitness, health, and the meal program at the center.

With the extended hours for the ESL class, we have incorporated more evening programing to benefit all seniors in our community. We work with the city to provide transportation for the evening. Having transportation has been very beneficial to our members who are unable to drive and those that have a harder time driving at night.
