| Week of August 3, 2015 | Draft of argument in favor of the ballot proposition (500-or-less words) is distributed by City Council Chair or designee. |
| Wednesday, August 5, 2015 | Chapman provides City with election resolution for inclusion in City Council packets for August 12, 2015 City Council meeting. |
| Week of August 10, 2015 | Comments due to City Council Chair or designee on initial draft of argument in favor of the ballot proposition. |
| Wednesday, August 12, 2015 | City Council considers election resolution that includes the ballot proposition, dollar amount of the bonds and the maximum maturity of the bonds and calls for the holding of public hearings on September 16, 2015 and October 28, 2015. |
| Week of August 17, 2015 | Revised draft of argument in favor of the ballot proposition distributed by City Council Chair or designee. |
| Wednesday, August 19, 2015 | Election resolution delivered to the Lieutenant Governor and the City Recorder by Chapman on behalf of the City. |
| Wednesday, August 26, 2015 | Comments due to City Council Chair or designee on revised draft of argument in favor of the ballot proposition. |
| Friday, August 28, 2015 | Final draft of argument in favor of the ballot proposition distributed by City Council Chair or designee. |

| Friday, August 28, 2015 | Chapman provides the City Recorder's office and the newspapers with the Notice of September 16, 2015 Public Hearing for posting and publication. |
| Wednesday, September 2, 2015 | First publication of Notice of September 16, 2015 Public Hearing. |
| Thursday, September 3, 2015 | The City Council Chair or designee submits argument in favor of the ballot proposition to the City Recorder. |
| Wednesday, September 9, 2015 | Second publication of Notice of September 16, 2015 Public Hearing. |
| Wednesday, September 16, 2015 | The City Council holds the first of two public hearings relating to the ballot proposition. |
| Wednesday, September 30, 2015 | Chapman provides Notice of Special Bond Election to newspapers for publication. |
| Friday, October 2, 2015 | City Council Chair or designee causes the arguments to be (i) posted to the Statewide Electronic Voter Information Website and to the City Council's website and (ii) published in the City Council's newsletter or other periodical (if applicable). Information regarding the October 28, 2015 public hearing is to immediately follow the arguments. |
| Tuesday, October 6, 2015 | First publication of the Notice of Special Bond Election. |
| Tuesday, October 13, 2015 | Second publication of the Notice of Special Bond Election. |
| Monday, October 19, 2015 | Voter information pamphlet mailed. |
| Tuesday, October 20, 2015 | Third publication of the Notice of Special Bond Election. |
| Wednesday, October 28, 2015 | The City Council holds second public hearing relating to the ballot proposition. |
| Friday, October 30, 2015 | City Council causes a video or audio recording of its October 28, 2015 public meeting to be posted on its website. |
| Tuesday, November 3, 2015 | Election Day. |
| Tuesday, November 17, 2015 at 6:00 p.m. | City Council holds special meeting ² to canvass the returns of the special bond election. |

² Utah Code § 11-14-207 requires the City Council to canvass returns no sooner than 7 days and not later than 14 days after the election. The City Council's currently scheduled meetings on November 4th and 18th do not fall within this time frame.
