

SUBJECT: LOCAL CAPITAL IMPROVEMENTS LISTS - PERMANENT COMMUNITY IMPACT FUND BOARD (PCIFB or simply CIB)
PROJECT PRIORITIZATION MEETING SCHEDULED

On August 15, 2008 a packet of information was mailed to every jurisdiction in the Five County region requesting updating and submitting Capital Improvements Lists (both 1-yr "short-term" proposed projects and 2-5 year "mid-range" potential projects) for inclusion in the regionally developed HUD Consolidated Plan. These lists are used for federal funding programs such as Community Development Block Grants (CDBG), etc., and are also used for state programs such as the Utah Permanent Community Impact Fund Board (PCIFB). The PCIFB, also known as the "CIB", provides loans and/or grants to jurisdictions throughout the state for infrastructure, planning and studies, public facilities and equipment. From the lists returned to us by the specified October 10th deadline, five separate consolidated lists (one for each county) were developed.

On October 27, 2008 a envelope of materials was mailed to each jurisdiction in the region that had submitted list in response to the aforementioned August 15th request. In this October 27th mailing a copy of both the 1-yr (2009) and 2-5yr Capital Improvement Lists for each responding jurisdiction was returned to the jurisdiction. These lists were compiled using the information provided by each respective jurisdiction. Also sent out were a consolidated, alphabetized, list of all projects within that jurisdiction's county that have been proposed for probable application to the PCIFB during 2009. That consolidated list will be prioritized [see following paragraph] and then submitted by the Five County Association of Governments to the Permanent Community Impact Fund Board.

A meeting, open to the public, has been scheduled wherein all jurisdictions that participated in this process by submitting their updated local lists are invited to meet and participate in prioritizing, by

group consensus, the 1-yr list of all projects located within each of the five counties of southwestern Utah, specifically for the PCIFB purposes.

A special note to any jurisdiction which did not participate in the process by returning your 1-year Capital Improvement List for a proposed CIB application by the October 10, 2008 deadline:

The meeting scheduled in your county will serve as the final opportunity for your jurisdiction to insure that a project proposed to be applied for to the PCIFB is in fact on the consolidated and prioritized list which will then be closed and submitted to the PCIFB for use in the 2009 Application cycles.
