Policy: **Dress Code**

Date:

The purpose of this policy is to enhance the learning environment of our children and cultivate an atmosphere of discipline, equality and respect.

Tops:

Shirts must be a collared style and of a solid or stripe color. Appropriate collared styles are: blouse, polo, oxford, turtleneck or dress shirt. Sleeveless shirts are not acceptable.

With the exception of the school name or logo, no logos, embellishments, advertising, graphics, appliqués or screen printing is acceptable.

Sweaters or sweater vests in a solid color or stripe may be worn over the acceptable collared shirt.

Bottoms:

Pants must be a solid colored, flat or pleated front in a chino/twill/khaki, corduroy or carpenter style. Shorts are to be no shorter than $\frac{3}{4}$ of the length between the hipbone and the kneecap.

Girls may wear skirts, jumpers, or cropped/capris. Skirts, shorts or jumpers are to be no shorter than $\frac{3}{4}$ of the length between the hip bone and the knee cap. Skirts or jumpers must have inconspicuous shorts worn underneath. Leggings or pants that show underneath these articles of clothing are not allowed.

Fridays will be designated as “casual Friday”, and students may wear denim pants with an appropriate top.

Unacceptable pants are as follows: leggings, cargo, gaucho, athletic or denim (except on “casual Fridays”).

Accessories: Solid colored, coordinating socks or tights must be worn at all times. Girls may also wear solid colored, smooth opaque and/or cable knit tights. No nylon stockings may be worn. Belts are optional. If worn, the belt should be solid brown, navy or black. Girls may wear jewelry or hair accessories that are appropriate for school and are not a distraction.

Unacceptable shoes include: open-toed, backless, character, sandals, lighted, wheels, and heels over 1”.

Outerwear:

Solid color sweatshirts with hoods (hereafter referred to as “hoodies”) in both pullover and zip-up styles may be worn. Hoodies with the approved OMCS school logo are acceptable. Acceptable shirts must be worn under hoodies at all times. Hoods may not be worn on the head while in the building.

Outerwear worn to/from school and at outside recess is not considered a dress code item. Snow boots must be changed into school approved shoes while inside the building.

Dress Uniform: All students will follow a specific field trip dress code for all field trips and on other specifically designated occasions. This dress code will be determined by the school’s governing board before the start of the school year.

Vendor Information

Clothing may be purchased wherever appropriate styles are available.

Regulations

1. The dress code at Oquirrh Mountain Charter School is mandatory. Dress and grooming standards are part of the Dress Code Regulations.
2. The above outlines dress code must be worn during school hours, Monday through Friday, except under specially designated circumstances as well as for all before and after school programs, except where activities require alternate attire (i.e. sports, dance, etc.).
3. Students must present a modest, clean, and neat appearance at all times.
4. All clothing must be clean, appropriately sized, and worn correctly.
5. Pants/shorts/skirts must be worn at the waist, shirts must be buttoned, shoes must be tied or fastened, clothing must be worn right side-out, appropriate underwear must be worn, etc. Clothing shall not be excessively worn or have holes.
6. Hair must be kept neat and have a combed and appropriate appearance for school. No extreme hair color or styles.
7. Any makeup worn should be appropriate for school.
8. No hats of any kind, including baseball caps, or sunglasses, may be worn in the building.
9. Dress items not specifically covered above but considered inappropriate or contrary to the Purpose statement in the School Uniform Policy are subject to review and interpretation by the Board of Directors.
