Re: Eastern Lake Mountains Target Shooting Plan Amendment

To Whom It May Concern:

The Utah County Commission requests that the BLM take into account the following concerns expressed by the public regarding the Eastern Lake Mountains Target Shooting Plan Amendment:

- 1. The proposed shooting range is unlikely to satisfy current demand, particularly on the weekends. Utah County Sheriff Jim Tracy estimates that between 500-700 people participate in target shooting in the area on the weekends, and the proposed shooting range cannot satisfy this demand.
- 2. Closing off all target shooting in surrounding areas is problematic because the proposed shooting range is too short for long-distance target shooters.
- 3. The proposed closures could magnify safety concerns by putting all target shooters in closer proximity to one another.
- 4. Illegal target shooting (e.g., shooting on private property or shooting at Native American petroglyphs) is a law enforcement issue, and closing off thousands of acres to target shooting is a draconian response.
- 5. SITLA is also considering a proposal to close off thousands of acres of its land in the area to target shooting, which will further limit access to target shooting options.
