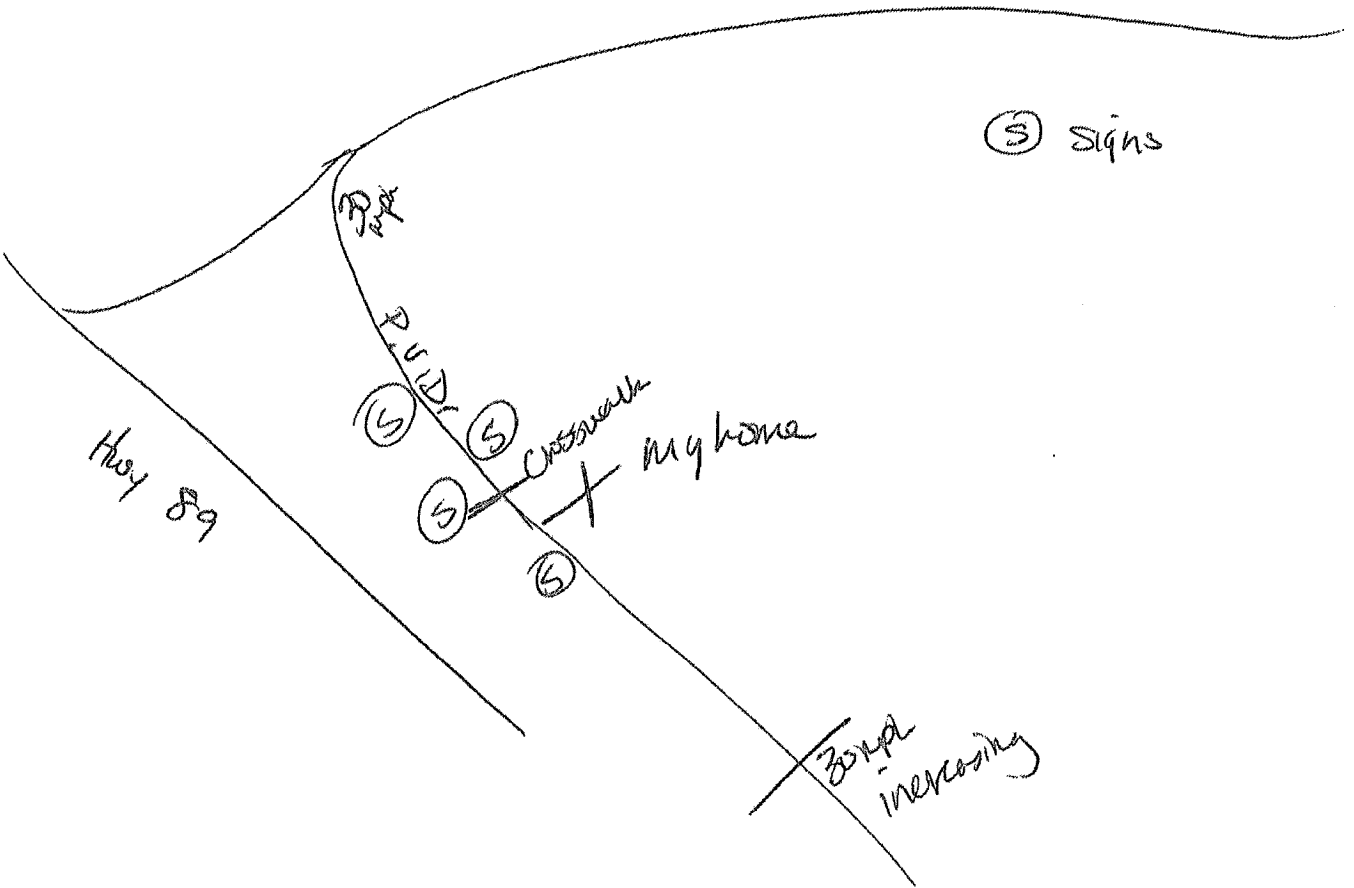

Dear planning team and decision makers for the Skyline Project,

I have reviewed the EA for the Skyline project. I am writing to support the Action Alternative to create safer pedestrian and vehicle travel conditions in the study area. Choosing the No Action Alternative is not a viable alternative as No Action is more likely to result in the eventual death or severe injury of pedestrians or drivers within the study area including students than not. The Action Alternative mitigates this risk of death or injury to the public very well and see the environmental impacts of implementing the Action Alternative were found to be insignificant.

My wife, daughter and I live on the corner of 500w across from Weber High and I am very concerned for our safety as we walk, bike or drive in our neighborhood. I am also very concerned for the safety of the students of Weber High and the local elementary schools, the residents of Pleasant View, and the community at large.

Please consider this additional input and substantive comment to the draft EA. We have lived in our home since February 2015. Since that time we have observed the Haul Truck Company greatly expand their operation on an annual basis. This is a changed condition from 2014 so stating that the No Action Alternative would not result in additional haul truck traffic does not seem correct.

- There are more trucks now than in 2015 thus there is an even greater likelihood of conflict with pedestrians and vehicles now than in 2014.
- They come earlier in the morning and leave later at night with peak times occurring when children/students are coming and going from school and their extracurricular activities. The parents along with their passengers who drop their children off at school must exit in a westerly direction onto 500w in the direct path of haul trucks who have impaired stopping ability due to their weight and the 14% grades.
- They operate on weekends and holidays while more people are out recreating, thus there is a greater likelihood of conflict with pedestrians and vehicles using the sidewalks and streets in No Action Alternative of the study area.



- The trailers they haul are much larger now than when we first arrived and carry much more weight with their extended trailers so their stopping potential is even more greatly delayed.
- They operate on steep grades (14%), even in snowy and icy conditions, thus their stopping potential is even more greatly delayed now and this should not be allowed to continue.
- On at least three occasions the haul trucks on their downhill descents have ran through the stop sign at the junction of Elberta and 500w and ended up in the field just east of 500w (personal communications to resident of 490 Elberta Drive). These un-reported incidents are the writing on the wall for the decision maker. It is a miracle that no one has been killed or injured at this intersection or on the steep grades of 500w or 600w yet.
- On a daily basis I observe numerous trucks breaking the speed limit. To verify they are breaking the speed limit I have driven behind them on multiple occasions clocking speeds of over 40 miles/hour up hill and 20-25 miles/hour down the hill. This is a production based industry so the incentive for the drivers to speed is inherent if they are paid by each load delivered in a day.
- As stated in the EA, the haul trucks have already been involved in 6 documented accidents in the study area including one fatality. The decision maker could avert disaster by making the correct decision which is implementing the Action Alternative. Choosing the No Action Alternative would be irresponsible as health and human safety is at stake.
