Utah School to Work Interagency Transition Initiative

Presenter - Tricia Jones-Parkin

DSPD won a grant to build capacity to provide competitive employment for youth and young adults. The Division, Workforce Services, Vocational Rehabilitation, Special Education, ASPIRE project, DD Council, Parent Center joined in an agreement and received the grant. A program level position has been posted, time limited, to improve these efforts. Outcome measurement system is being developed for data share across states. Tricia met with Special Education directors and we've heard great outcomes for discovery.

Q: Is this also aimed at kids with Supported Living Services? We have some latitude to bring in curriculum.

1.3 Directive Review:

The Division updated the ICD9 to ICD10 (ICD=International Statistical Classification of Diseases and Related Health Problems) reference, Comprehensive Brain Injury Assessment (CBIA) 2.0 to 3.0, and a reference to the annual State Eligibility Committee directive (not completed yet).

Analysis of One-Time Respite

The Division performed an evaluation of the One-Time Respite program through a survey. The Division found negative reactions to family skill building training material as it was not specific to disabilities.

It also found limitations in the rural area and Salt Lake County.

People felt the pay was too low to attract quality staff.

The Division provided some open ended responses supporting the program.

The Division presented service improvement items.
