BACKGROUND DISCUSSION:

On November 7, 2016, one of the K-9 handlers separated from service. PSD "Pyro" has another 2-3 years of useful service; however, the training time would be approximately one year to bring him up to speed with a new handler. We have looked at our staffing and have decided to reallocate this position as a full patrol position so we will not reassign that K-9 position but instead to operate with only three K-9 teams. The police department has determined to surplus Police Service Dog (PSD) "Pyro". PSD "Pyro" will be sold per city policy as surplus property, hopefully to another agency, or kennel.

**A RESOLUTION TO DECLARE AS SURPLUS

WHEREAS, pursuant to West Jordan Municipal Code 2-7-324, the City Council must declare any City property surplus prior to disposal,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF WEST JORDAN, UTAH, THAT:

Section 1. The City Council declares PSD "Pyro" as surplus, and authorizes the change of ownership:
