*RE: Contract for Dispatch Services*

Dear Chief Stone,

The Weber Area Dispatch 911 & Emergency Services District ("Weber 911") recently signed a contract with Morgan County to provide dispatch services to the entire county for the next two years. That contract goes into effect as of 12:01 a.m. on January 1, 2017. The Mountain Green Fire District ("Fire District") was specifically included in that contract to receive services. As a result, it will no longer be necessary for the Fire District to contract separately Weber 911.

Weber 911's current contract with the Fire District is set to terminate at midnight on June 30, 2018. Because residents of the Fire District will begin paying for dispatch services through their property taxes to Morgan County under the contract with the county as of January 1, 2017, I propose that we terminate our contract early so that residents of the Fire District are not charged twice for the same service.

Paragraph 5.2 of our contract provides that either party may terminate the contract by giving 180 days prior notice. Unfortunately, terminating the contract in that manner would put the termination date well into next year. Paragraph 7.1 provides that our contract may be amended "by a written amendment approved and signed by all Parties." In order to terminate the contract by December 31, 2016 I propose that we amend the termination date in our existing contract. That way the Fire District will continue to have coverage through the end of this year through the existing contract, and beginning January 1, 2017 you will have coverage through the new contract with Morgan County.

I have included a proposed amendment to our contract with this letter. If you agree, please sign the proposed amendment and return it to me so that I can get it approved by Weber 911's administrative control board.
