

Notice of Intent to Amend the Central Davis Sewer District - Capital Facility Plan

Central Davis Sewer District's Board of Trustees gives notice of its intent to Amend the District Capital Facility Plan for the area generally bounded by the following description and shown on the included map:

AREA DESCRIPTION

The area under consideration is generally west of I-15, North of Clark Lane, East of the UTA track alignment (the old Denver and Rio Grande Railroad) and South or adjacent to Burke Lane.

This area has been zoned by Farmington City for possible high density residential which greatly exceeds the District's estimated flows for the area. The specific area is shown on the included map. The District's current Capital Facility Plan includes this area as low density residential and trunk lines and the treatment plant have been planned and constructed accordingly. In addition, the high flows in the area will require a major pump station. The current Capital Facility Plan anticipated a low pressure variable grade pressure system for this area.
