The North Ogden City Council convened in a special meeting on January 19, 2018 at 6:34 p.m. at the North Ogden City Office at 505 East 2600 North.

Mayor Pro Temp Cheryl Stoker called the meeting to order. Council Member Turner offered the invocation and led the audience in the Pledge of Allegiance.

1. SWEARING IN OF TEMPORARY MAYOR

City Recorder Spendlove administered the Oath of Office to Temporary Mayor Brent Chugg.

2. DISCUSSION AND/OR ACTION TO CONSIDER A TEMPORARY SEWER BOARD APPOINTMENT

Mayor Chugg conducted discussion regarding the Council's appointment of a member of the City's Governing Body to a position on the Central Weber Sewer District Board. Council Member Turner asked that he be allowed to read an email sent by Mayor Taylor regarding this matter. "The Sewer District is in need of a new North Ogden representative for the next four years. Every four years this position must be reappointed in North Ogden and for nearly all other cities in the District, the Mayor is the representative. I

would ask that you please reappoint me for the next four years, but also select a temporary replacement among yourselves for the next year. The meetings are once a month on Mondays and, if Mayor Chugg would like to do this, I would recommend him or any member of the Council.”

Council Member Turner motioned to appoint Mayor Taylor to the Central Weber Sewer District for the next four years, with Temporary Mayor Chugg as a temporary replacement during Mayor Taylor’s deployment. Council Member Swanson seconded the motion.

Council Member Swanson then motioned to cancel all meetings until February 6, 2018. Council Member Stoker seconded the motion.


