Update on the Safety and Sanitation Symposium

Licensing (DOPL) is offering lunch & three hours of CE credit on cosmetology-related safety and sanitation in salons, spas and shops. The meeting is scheduled for Monday June 3rd. from 12:00-4:00 pm. The symposium will be at the Karen Gayle Miller Conference Center. The invitations have gone out to all licensed Environmental Health Scientist and to the twelve Directors of the Health Department. Additional information will be sent to the Cosmetology Schools or their instructors. They have until April 30 to register for the Safety and Sanitation Symposium. There will be a speaker, from Kings Research and a panel. The Board recommended Ms. Veasy also be on that panel, she stated that would be fine. The Symposium

is designed to educate people.

Rule Changes

The legislature changed the law, which made a rule changed necessary. The first change is in definitions R 156-11a-102(1) needs a subsection number change. The act was re numbered so the rule must also be re numbered. There will be a renumbering change in (4), (5), subsection 11(a), (!5), (18), (19) and (20). The word "Substantially" has been added to R156-11a-302(3). To protect students if a school closes. Section 605 sets a time limit for the retention of records to be a minimum of 10 years and the Trustee shall provide information during that time The Board discussed what ramifications the changes may make. Ms. Reintjes made a motion seconded by Ms. Anderson to accept the changes as noted above. The voting was unanimous. Ms. Stewart noted the approved rules would move forward independently of any other discussion.

Distance Learning and Online Learning.

Online The Board discussed distance learning and online and education. The cosmetologist professions is very much a hands on profession it could only be the theory portion that could be done online or through distance education. The Board noted the curriculum would have to take in to consideration the statute which currently stated students must be under direct supervision. Board noted you can not fall back on the General Rule when there are already rules within the profession. Ms. Parkin offered to do some research and Ms. Frasier offered to get the Board information from a national source as to what other schools in the nation are doing and how they are doing their training programs. There are still many issues to discuss to determine if Distance Education or Online Education to determine if those programs would be legal and /or beneficial to the program. Another concern is the students need to have an opportunity to learn people skills or interpersonal skills before the schools to send them out. The Board noted this was just a discussion item. The Board stated they would meet again in June 3rd 2013.
