**RESOLUTION NO. 23-23**

**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF TAYLORSVILLE APPROVING A GRANT FROM  
THE UTAH DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC SAFETY IN THE AMOUNT OF \$80,000 FOR  
THE PURPOSE OF ASSISTING WITH THE COSTS OF PROVIDING MENTAL  
HEALTH RESOURCES TO FIRST RESPONDERS.**

**WHEREAS**, the Taylorsville City Council (the “Council”) met in regular session on August 2, 2023, to consider, among other things, accepting a grant from the Utah Department of Public Safety in the amount of \$80,000 for the purpose of assisting with the costs of providing mental health resources to first responders; and

**WHEREAS**, UTAH CODE ANN. § 53-21-103 permits the Utah Department of Public Safety (“DPS”) to award grants to first responder agencies to provide mental health services in response to a request for proposal, request for qualifications, or program description; and

**WHEREAS**, DPS has awarded the Taylorsville Police Department a grant in the amount of \$80,000 for the purpose of assisting in the costs of providing mental health resources to the police department’s first responders pursuant to UTAH CODE ANN. § 53-21-103; and

**WHEREAS**, TAYLORSVILLE MUNICIPAL CODE § 2.32.180 provides that any grant that anticipates or proposes to bind the City to a particular project or contract shall be submitted to the Council for approval prior to accepting the grant; and

**WHEREAS**, after careful consideration, the Council has determined that it is in the best interests of the health, safety, and welfare of the citizens of the City to approve this grant from the Utah Department of Public Safety.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** that the Taylorsville City Council hereby approves and accepts the \$80,000 grant from DPS for the above-stated purpose and directs the City Administrator to include this amount in the 2023-2024 Mid-Year or Year-End Budget Adjustments, increasing both revenue and corresponding expenditure lines.

This Resolution, assigned Resolution No. 23-23, shall take effect immediately upon passage and acceptance as provided herein.
