- "Charter school agreement" or "Charter agreement" means a written agreement between a charter school and its authorizer containing the terms and conditions for the operation of a charter school.
- (b) The charter school agreement maintained by a charter school's authorizer is the final, official, and complete agreement.
 - (5) "Charter school deficiency" means:
- 28 (a) failure of a charter school to comply with its charter agreement, including 29 governance, financial, academic, or operational obligations;

([13]14) "Operating charter school" means a charter school that has received minimum school program funds or federal funds and is providing educational services during a fiscal year.

([14]15) "Probation" means a written formal action and notification through which a school is required to demonstrate the school's compliance with the authorizer's probationary requirements.

([15]<u>16</u>) "Restricted revenue" means the same as the term is defined in Section 63J-1-102.

([16]17) "Satellite school" means a charter school affiliated with an existing charter school physically located within the state of Utah that:

- (a) has the same governing board as the existing charter school;
- (b) has the same authorizer as the existing charter school;
- (c) may have a similar or different program of instruction or grades served from the existing charter school;
- (d) is located at a different site or in a different geographical area than the existing charter school; and
 - (e) has a separate school number than the existing charter school.
