Legislative Issues

S.B. 116 Local Health Department Modifications

- This bill removes the authority of local health departments to isolate and quarantine an individual; and allows a local health department to *recommend* that an individual isolate or quarantine.
- Used infrequently as there are many restrictions and checks & balances in place to not abuse.

H.B. 71 Local Health Department Revisions

• This bill will require the State to discuss with local health department before issuing rule that would affect public health.

Does not apply to low-risk food
