## SUMMARY

Through the AHG program, projects that serve households that earn 30% or less of Area Median Income (AMI) will be provided monthly rental subsidy which will allow the property to provide case management services and deeply affordable rental units. Through this program, projects will generate enough rental income to ensure supportive services are provided to every household residing in an AHG-designated unit.

Applications were submitted on July 17, 2023. A total of seven applications were reviewed, totaling \$2,193,048 in requests to support 209 deeply affordable rental units. A group of community experts reviewed applications to provide recommendations to the Council for approval. Reading and scoring were completed on August 4, 2023.

After reviewing and scoring applications, six projects were recommended for funding to support 134 units of deeply affordable housing. These projects will require an estimated \$1,305,648 per year in annual support. Contract negotiations will start immediately upon approval by the Council.
