#### 2. EXECUTIVE SUMMARY

The tax rate certified by Salt Lake County for the District is 0.000778 which will generate property tax revenue of \$10,133. The Board amended the FY 2024 Tentative Budget for the District to propose a property tax rate increase of 10%, or 0.000856 which will generate property tax revenue of \$11,149. The Board listened to several options and held a public hearing on August 22, 2023. The Board must adopt a property tax rate to be levied for tax year 2023 for the District. The Board may adopt any rate at or below the stated increase of 0.000856 (or 10%).

#### 3. TIME SENSITIVITY / URGENCY

Utah State Code requires a property tax rate be levied by September 1<sup>st</sup> of the tax year for a fiscal year entity.

#### 4. FISCAL NOTE

The FY 2024 Annual Budget will need to be amended to match any change in revenue. It is recommended any changes be offset by a use of reserves.

#### 2. EXECUTIVE SUMMARY

The Board accepted the FY 2024 Proposed Budget on April 12, 2023 and adopted the FY 2024 Tentative Budget on April 26, 2023 at which time the date for a public hearing on the budget was set for June 14, 2023. The Board held a community outreach meeting on June 7, 2023 to solicit public comment and inform the District residents of the financial status of the District. A public hearing was held on June 14, 2023, wherein the an amendment to the budget was presented for public comment. The Board amended the FY 2024 Tentative Budget in a regularly schedule public meeting on June 28, 2023 and proposed a 10% property tax revenue increase. A public hearing was held on August 22, 2023 regarding the property tax rate. The budget has been available to the public during this time period.

The budget will need to be amended to reflect any changes to the property tax rate and revenue as adopted in **Resolution No. 011**.

#### 3. TIME SENSITIVITY / URGENCY

Utah State Code requires a final budget be adopted no later than June 30<sup>th</sup>, or September 1<sup>st</sup> in the case of a change to the property tax rate.

#### 4. FISCAL NOTE

Any change from the property tax rate of 0.000856 will need to be amended in the budgeted revenues. Recommend any change be offset by a use of reserves.


#### **FUND DESCRIPTION & PURPOSE**

The Fairway Estates Special Service Recreation District is a separate taxing entity created to provide park strip landscaping services to the area within the district. The service demand is in excess of normal city-provided services.

#### **GOVERNING BOARD**

The District is managed by a Governing Board of seven trustees consisting of the members of the West Jordan City Council. Meetings are held at such times and places as needed, with an annual meeting held for the purpose of setting the annual property tax rate, electing trustees and officers.

#### **PROPERTY TAX RATE HISTORY**



The Board is proposing a not-greater-than 10% property tax increase in the Amended Tentative Budget for FY 2024. This increase is intended to reduce the use of reserves while also addressing the increased cost of services.

Chair McConnehey called the meeting to order at 6:00 pm

#### 2. BUSINESS ITEMS

a. Review of survey responses from residents of Fairway Estates Special Service Recreation District

Council Office Director Alan Anderson reported on survey results received from respondents from the district. With 51 property owners in the district, 22 responses were collected, and 20 of those responses were included in their packet. Additional responses received the day prior to the meeting were incorporated in the presentation offered.

Survey questions covered:

- 1. Preferred rate of increase for family need
- 2. Interest in creating a board from residents to oversee park management
- 3. Availability and interest in serving a four-year term on the board
- 4. Suggestions for park improvement or feedback on care

Survey results were outlined as follows:

- Option B (no increase this year, 25% in 2025) was preferred by over 45%.
- Option C (delayed property tax increase) gathered just over 25% support.
- Option A (around 10-11% increase) was chosen only less than 20%.

• Nearly 70% favored creating a board, but only 26% were willing to serve, with nearly 35% uninterested. Creating a board would require code amendments.

Board Member Pack valued the innovative options, praising out of the box thinking for ideas that had not previously been considered.

Board Member Whitelock inquired if residents were aware of the cost associated with forming a board. Mr. Anderson noted that an information packet accompanied the postcard, however, the increased costs to form the board were not mentioned.
