CAPACITY PROJECT PRIORITIZATION PROCESS

Stephanie Tomlin, UDOT Planning Program Manager, reviewed the 2023 updates to the TIF/TTIF Capacity Project Prioritization Process model. She talked about the development and input process, reviewing the 2023 update goals, the update process, the collaborative and iterative process, and the update schedule. She described how recommended criteria weights are developed, tested, reviewed, adjusted and evaluated before being adopted.

She also talked about addressing the legislative requirements and the technical documentation, which must be reviewed and approved by the Commission.

Stephanie reviewed the proposed prioritization models, each of their individual measures, and measure weighting recommendations.

In the next step of the process, nominations will be open from June 26 to August 31, and approval of the new process document will be requested at the August 2023 Utah Transportation Commission Meeting.

Andrew Gruber, Wasatch Front Regional Council Executive Director, LaNiece Davenport, Mountainland Association of Government Planning and Policy Director, and Jory Johner, Wasatch Front Regional Council Director of Long-Range Planning each expressed their appreciation of the partnership and inclusion during the process.

Andrew Gruber said UDOT staff has done a terrific job taking complicated and important issues and achieving a balance of urban and rural, fast growing and slow growing areas, and thinking about how transportation relates to local growth patterns, housing, development, job creation, and open spaces and how it all relates to quality of life.

Laniece Davenport added that the MPOs felt heard and included.

Leif Elder, UDOT Policy and Legislative Services Director, emphasized the trust of the Legislature in, and the importance of the Commission's role and what a big impact it has for people across the State, from one end to the other
