The Board decided to make the new meeting time at 4:00 PM on the third Thursday of the month.

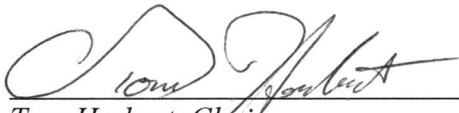
D. WATER AND SEWER OPTIONS AT THE AIRPORT

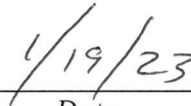

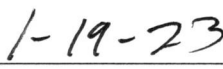
