DISCUSSION ON PROPOSED COUNTY SALES AND USE TAX FOR EMERGENCY MEDICAL SERVICES.


Commissioner Iverson started the discussion with updates gathered since the last meeting.

There was in-depth dialog about modifying the EMS tax at the legislative level to clearly define options available to meet needs in particular EMS areas.

Due to concerns with the current bill, the commissioners would like to work cooperatively with the municipalities and the fire district on a legislative change to the EMS tax. The EMS tax will not be on the commission agenda next week, so this will not be on the ballot this year.

Another Work Meeting will be held to continue evaluations on the matter.
