**DISCUSSION ON PROPOSED COUNTY SALES AND USE TAX FOR EMERGENCY MEDICAL SERVICES.**


Commissioner Snow commenced the meeting discussion with his concerns regarding tax increases to fund Fire and EMS Service needs throughout the county.
