Mayor Nay opened the meeting at 6:05 P.M.

Kelly was asked to give the Council an update on the new test wells project. He discussed status and a recent report by Willowstick who used subsurface sonar and mapping techniques to show higher potential areas. The report looked at two sites: near the existing treatment facility and on the foothills near Tar Canyon. The Tar Canyon site is their recommended site, but it will cost double or triple because of the amount of piping back to the treatment plant. Different qualities of water can be found at different depths of the wells. The Tar Canyon site may have high nitrates like the Hays Canyon well that Centerfield drilled, but the Hays Canyon had nearly 2,000 gallons per minute. The site near the treatment facility appears to have much lower potential of flows.

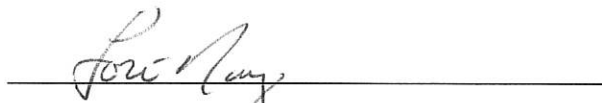
Consensus was to continue moving forward with drilling of both test wells. The cost can be covered by using water bond reserve funds. The city can then evaluate options.

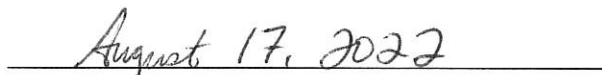
