

Parks, Trails & Open Space

Outcomes & Indicators 2024

Current Outcomes and Indicators are based upon internal tracking of work orders to illustrate our responsiveness.

Current Outcome: Salt Lake County Parks & Recreation provides well-maintained parks, trails and open spaces for the public to safely enjoy at their leisure.

Current Indicators:

- Percentage of work orders completed or addressed within two-weeks to improve caretaking and maintenance levels for parks, trails and open spaces. Target 100%, through July 31st, 39%
- Percent of public interest work orders are completed or addressed within forty-eight (48) hours to improve caretaking and maintenance levels for parks, trails and open spaces. Target 90%, through July 31st, 85%

Current Outcome: Salt Lake County Parks & Recreation provides a variety of well-maintained single-use, multi-use and regionally connected trail options for the public to use.

Current Indicator:

Percentage of dedicated (Trails and Open Space team), front-line @ seasonal staff hours spent monitoring and maintain trails and open space to accommodate multiple users regionwide. Target, 85%, through July 31st, 73%

Proposed Outcomes and Indicator reflect actual usage of our parks spaces and are meant to quantify how the public loves our spaces.

Parks Narrative: # Of Parks managed.

- 9 Class 1 Regional Parks, 876 acres total, 600 developed
- 4,402 Acres of Regional Open Space
- 188 Miles of Regional Trails, 153 developed
- 36 Class 11 Regional Parks, 710 acres total, 565 developed

Outcome: Parks, Trails & Open Spaces provides hundreds of miles of accessible multi-use trails for active transportation, recreation and healthy living throughout the Salt Lake Valley for the public to enjoy at their leisure.

Indicators:

Trail counters to track utilization along the Parley's Trail (east/west), the Jordan River Trail (north/south) and the Bonneville Shoreline Trails (perimeter of the valley).

Outcome: Parks, Trails & Open Spaces will continue to expand access to and reduce barriers to recreation and healthy living by providing accessible and welcoming spaces in our parks- and outdoor recreational facilities.

Parks, Trails & Opens Space

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Indicators:

- Number of outdoor field rentals (42 ballfields, 19 multiuse fields, 11 tennis courts, 4 cricket pitches, 16 pickleball courts & 3 disc golf courses), total impact of field rentals (participants+spectators+vendors), Target 90%
- Number of school tours @ Wheeler Historic Farm
- Number of school tour participants
- Pavilion rentals on our 17 reservable park pavilions, rental participants in these facilities, Target 90%
 - 17 Total Number Reservable Pavilions, reserved each day except for holidays, April through September
 - 2,233 Persons Pavilion Capacity per day

Outcome: Parks, Trails & Open Spaces continues to provide access to and reduce barriers to outdoor recreation in Millcreek Canyon.

Indicators:

- Number of annual passes sold
- Number of annual visitors
- Number of Yurt Rentals (seasonal)
