1. Please list activities and programs completed this month that support:

a) Language Arts and Mathematics Ends Policy

2023 EOY Data has been shared with the Board. Goals were met by LVA and growth continues to occur in reading. BOY data will be shared in the October meeting. ROAR reading groups begin in September. Teachers are using BOY data to place the students in leveled groups to work on specific skills.

b) Science, Arts, and Technology Ends policy

We are beginning the work on our first Drama club performance of the year. We had 80 students audition and anticipate another 30 for tech crew. Mr. Sare, as our Innovative Coach, has been working with our teachers to survey needs and help us implement technology in our instruction. Adding Canvas this year as the platform for teachers to teach and students to learn is going well. We held 3 trainings for teachers on building and using this platform and continue to support them one on one as needed. We are building the support resources to families on our website. Students are engaging with this platform very well. We have replaced all aging student chrome books and teacher equipment. The Board should be seeing invites from grade levels regarding goals in this area.
