103 working group.

105 *A motion to recommended “Ongoing funding for: 1. Permanent supportive housing at 15 million; 2.*
106 *Olene Walker gap financing of 10 million; 3. Homeless mitigation of 2.5 million; 4. HCD staff support at*
107 *\$318,000. One-time funding for: 1. Deeply affordable housing of 50 million; 2. Housing preservation of 25*
108 *million. Funding from a new source for: 1. Dedicated funding source for homelessness of \$39 million”*
109 *was made by Senator Fillmore.*

111 *There was discussion of a substitute motion, but it was discarded and the Commission approved the*
112 *original motion. All commissioners in attendance were in favor.*
