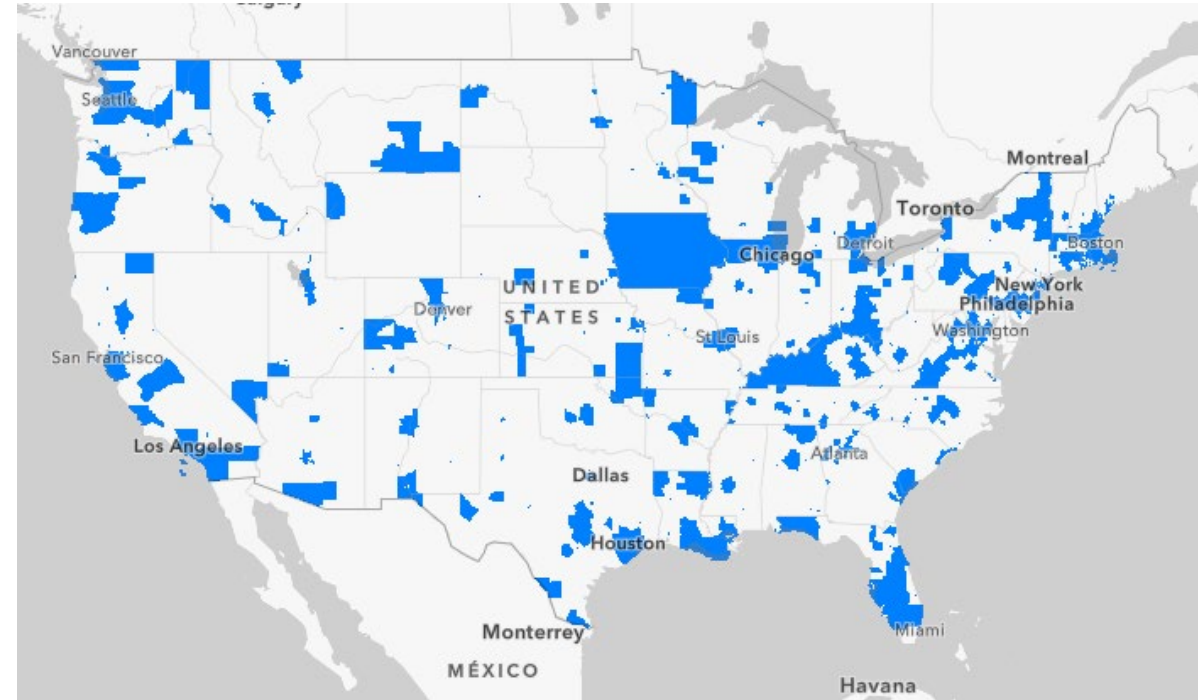


MAG Safety Action Plan

- US DOT Safe Streets for All (SS4A) Grant Program
 - \$1B per year for 5 years
- Two Grant Types
 1. Planning Grants
 2. Implementation Grants
- MAG awarded a 2022 Planning Grant to complete a Safety Action Plan



MAG Safety Action Plan

- Key Factors

1. Position for future Implementation Grants
2. Elevate safety in the MPO/RPO project planning and prioritization process

 - Concept drawings and cost estimates for 3 packages of projects
- Queued up for final 3 years of SS4A Implementation Grants
 - 2024
 - 2025
 - 2026
- Local government coordination – Project Identification
 - Early vetting late this year
 - Local support

Next Steps & Timeline

- Ongoing: Crash analysis and public engagement
- Early October: Stakeholder Committee Meetings begin
- Late 2023: Early project identification
- Spring 2024: Plan adoption
- June 2024: First package of project concepts complete
- July 204: Anticipated Implementation Grant deadline
