WELCOME

• Andre calls the meeting to order and takes roll. A quorum is not present.

APPROVAL OF MINUTES FOR JUNE AND JULY MEETINGS

- Andre states that without a quorum the minutes cannot be approved, but asks whether there were any discussion items relating to the minutes.
- Larry and Ben both indicate that they have reviewed the minutes and don't have concerns with them.
- Andre asks Robert and Rhett about UDOT's communication plan and who the point
 person might be if an amusement ride incident were to occur. Rhett comments that he
 does not have an update at this time but intends to provide one at the subsequent
 meeting. Larry comments that the state recently developed resources to help with public
 announcements in crisis situations that could be used.

FUTURE COMMITTEE MEETING FREQUENCY

 Andre asks the committee members to comment on changing the meeting frequency to every other month or quarterly. Larry and Ben both indicate that meeting quarterly would be preferred.

COMMITTEE TERMS AND APPOINTMENTS

• Andre summarizes that Cara, Larry, and Andre have been reappointed for two more years and Johnnie, Ben, and Pam have been reappointed for four more years.

Publication of Currently Permitted Amusement Rides

- Rhett asks the committee whether a publicly available list of currently permitted amusement rides is desired. Andre states that a list of registered ropeways is publicly available and likes the idea of being consistent with the ropeways.
- Andre expresses a timeliness concern and asks how soon the list of permitted
 amusement rides would be updated. Ben asks whether other states list their rides. Rhett
 responds that some states do and some don't, some appear to have an updated list while
 others seem to be old and outdated. Rhett anticipates that the list would be tied to the
 online system, which would update the public list in near-real time and to have separate
 lists for permanent and mobile amusement rides.
- Larry comments in favor of increased transparency and states that the number one complaint he receives is the frustration and difficulty in finding the website to register amusement rides.

CURRENT STATE OF AMUSEMENT RIDE ONLINE SYSTEM

Rhett demonstrates improved search engine optimization when searching for the
registration sites and states that the information can now be found within the UDOT
Permits website. Robert asks for opinions on whether the committee needs its own
webpage. Several committee members express favorable sentiments and Rhett says that
he will look into how this might be done.

CURRENT STATE OF PERMIT APPLICATIONS AND PERMITS ISSUED AND QSI APPLICATIONS AND QSIS APPROVED

• Rhett states that a few new mobile and permanent ride permits were recently issued..

INTRODUCTION FACT SHEET

• Rhett displays a draft fact sheet that he wants to use to introduce amusement ride safety requirements and information to new contacts. He further comments that information

about rider responsibility will be added. Several committee members comment that they would like to look over the fact sheet prior to its distribution.

REVIEW AND APPROVE REPORTABLE SERIOUS INJURY NOTIFICATION FORM, QSI APPROVAL CERTIFICATE, AND AMUSEMENT RIDE PERMIT

- Ben recommends a change on the reportable serious injury notification form. The
 sentence, "After a Reportable Serious Injury, the owner/operator may not operate a
 mobile amusement ride until the owner/operator receives written authorization from the
 Director or the Director's designee." incorrectly indicates that no ride may be operated
 when it should just be "the" ride on which the reportable serious injury occurred. The
 committee agrees.
- There are no recommended changes to the QSI Approval Certificate and Amusement Ride Permit.

ROUNDTABLE

- Rhett indicates that the committee will need to select a new committee chair at the subsequent committee meeting.
- Andre states that the date of the next committee meeting is incorrectly the first Wednesday of September instead of the typically scheduled second Wednesday on September 13. Larry comments that he will be tied up with the fair opening on September 7th and wouldn't be able to make a meeting on September 13. Andre asks Rhett to reach out to the committee members to determine the best date to ensure a quorum is present at the September meeting.
- Andre comments that Lagoon hosted an IAAPA Presents event with about 85 industry participants.
