July Distribution Summary

Statewide

\$89,110,356.09 sent to LEAs in July for schools meeting funding requirements.

\$12,719,776.93 withheld in July for schools not meeting funding requirements.

Districts

\$89,920,206.31 total planned for 2023-2024 distribution to districts.

896, approximately, district schools are eligible for funding due to reporting an enrollment count. It is approximate because some schools receive combined funding.

\$81,126,501.55 sent to LEAs for schools meeting funding requirements.

826, approximately, schools are receiving funding in July. It is approximate because a few schools combine for the purposes of the School LAND Trust Program.

\$8,793,704.76 was withheld for schools not meeting funding requirements.

70 schools had funding withheld in July for missing requirements some are new schools that will not submit until school begins.

Piute District is the only district receiving no funds in July. The district has been contacted due to extensive missing requirements and will be working on meeting the deadline for August funding.



Districts that have been partially funded due to missing requirements are: Alpine, Duchesne, Garfield, Granite, Jordan, Nebo, Washington, Provo, Logan, and Canyons.

All other districts were fully funded for meeting requirements.

Charter Schools

\$11,862,141.09 total planned for 2023-2024 distribution to charter schools.

140 charter schools are eligible for funding.

\$7,936,068.92 sent to LEAs for schools meeting funding requirements.

94 charter schools are receiving funding in July.

\$3,926,072.17 withheld for charter schools not meeting funding requirements.

46 charter schools had funding withheld for July for missing requirements.

USDB

\$47,785.62 total planned for 2023-2024 distribution to USDB.

\$47,785.62 sent to USDB for meeting funding requirements.

\$0.00 withheld for not meeting funding requirements.

August 25th Update for August 2023 Distribution

LEAs and schools have until August 7th to complete requirements for an August distribution.

Most districts will have received full funding with the additional August distribution. A few districts have new schools that will not assemble a council and complete requirements until school begins. Funding will be distributed for those schools after the school year begins.

As of July 25th (Board back-up due date):

37 Additional district schools have completed the requirements to receive funding.

33 Additional charter schools have completed the requirements to receive funding.

The remaining approximately 46 schools will receive funding in August or in following monthly distributions.
