CONSIDERATION OF RESOLUTION NO. R-2023-3174, A RESOLUTION APPROVING THE COUNCIL OF GOVERNMENTS RECOMMENDATIONS

County Engineer Todd Edwards stated the Council of Governments (COG) serves as a recommending body to Washington County and oversees the expenditures of local transportation corridor preservation funds. There are three (3) projects being recommended for funding which are: The approval of a Hurricane City funding request of \$80,000 from the Preservation Fund for roadway right-of-way acquisition for a portion of 300 West Street. The second request is for the approval of a Washington City funding request of \$40,000 from the Construction Grant Fund to acquire right-of-way acquisition for a multi-purpose trail on SR-18 near Veyo and Central. The third request is the approval of de-obligation of \$675,000 in funding from the Construction Grant Fund for right-of-way for the Northern Corridor alignment.

Public Works Director Ron Whitehead explained this agreement is a multi-jurisdictional grant application to stop the spread of invasive weeds.

Mr. Whitehead stated this subcontract to the master road agreement with Dixie National Forest further states specifics regarding funding amounts and roads to be maintained.

Greater Zion Tourism Director Brittany McMichael reported the grant agreement are for Spring Hollow and Grass Valley trail system in the Dixie National Forest.

MOTION: Motion by Commissioner Almquist to Approve Resolution No. R-2023-3177, A Resolution Accepting a Grant Agreement Regarding the Spring Hollow Mountain Biking Trails. Motion seconded by Commissioner Iverson and carried by unanimous vote, with Commissioners Snow and Iverson voting aye.

PUBLIC HEARING: WASHINGTON COUNTY TOURISM ADVISORY BOARD'S RECOMMENDATION TO ASSIST IN FUNDING THE ZION CANYON MUSIC FESTIVAL

MOTION: Motion by Commissioner Snow to Open the Public Hearing.

Erika Hodges discussed not funding private companies.

Rick Wixom, Springdale Town Manager, requested the Commissioners approve the Resolution.

Zachary Ray questioned how much the County invests in events such as this.

Commissioner Iverson stated that forty-three percent (43%) of TRT funding is required by state mandate to be spent on advertising.

Dan Cooper discussed communism.

Wendy Godlewski disagreed with TRT tax in general.

MOTION: Motion by Commissioner Snow to Close the Public Hearing.

CONSIDERATION OF RESOLUTION NO. R-2023-3178, A RESOLUTION APPROVING TRT EVENT FUNDING FOR THE 2024 ZION MUSIC FESTIVAL

Commissioner Iverson expressed approval for the well run nature of the event. He further discussed Grand County stopping advertising and the adverse effects that have happened, and the history of the TRT.

Commissioner Snow explained that state law regarding TRT expenditures are quite restrictive. He stated that the Washington County economy is tied to Zion National Park, with events such as this aiming to diversify tourism.

Commissioner Almquist discussed businesses such as restaurants and hotels that would close if Washington County followed the example of Grand County and stopped promoting tourism.

Commissioner Iverson explained the County works to ensure TRT are spread through the cities.

MOTION: Motion by Commissioner Almquist to Approve Resolution No. R-2023-3178, A Resolution Approving TRT Event Funding for the 2024 Zion Music Festival. Motion seconded by Commissioner Iverson and carried by unanimous vote, with Commissioners Snow and Iverson voting aye.

Commissioner Snow discussed the state legislature meeting being held in Washington County and the work being done advocating for Washington County. He stated the current public comment format will be changing going forward, with an open public comment period happening before meetings from 3:30 to 4:00 PM being held as a town hall style.

Clerk-Auditor Ryan Sullivan updated the Commission on the results of the Primary election, including audits and new machine reports. He read aloud the results from the September 5, 2023 primary election. He reported that there are 104,432 registered voters with 66,864 registered

Republicans, and there were 38,167 ballots that were cast in the election. Those numbers indicate a 36.55% voter turnout, with a 46.43% Republican turnout.

Commissioner Iverson commended Mr. Sullivan on his hard work during this election. Commissioner Snow further discussed Mr. Sullivan's dedication. Mr. Sullivan thanked his staff and all the volunteers that helped in the election.

SAR responded to the Squirrel Canyon Trail head on a report from a third party for a group of 8 hikers and 6 dogs unable to come down the trail due to flooding. Search and Rescue, DPS helicopter Star 7, and Colorado City Fire responded to locate and assist the hikers. Star 7 was able to fly out all 8 hikers and 6 dogs to a nearby park before another storm came through. All parties involved were rescued and there were no injuries.
