- McKenzie: Suggested we give feedback. Questions were a bit advanced for a 1-2 grader.
- Parental consent is not required for this presentation. Suzanne Kimball asked if we should give schools the option to present.
- All members were ok with the presentation and giving schools that option. All wanted to send recommendations to Family Haven for pre and post test questions.
- Members decided all other pre and post test questions to be ok on the Family Haven. Members were also happy that names were not required on the post test.
